<p>Apply in person for a U.S. Passport at the Costa Mesa Post Office or another location that will accept passport applications as soon as possible.</p> <p>Bring student’s Certified U.S. Birth Certificate, completed forms, parent(s) and passport photos. Do not sign forms until asked to do so.</p> <p>One parent must attend for youth age 16 & 17.
