

Passport Application Information – Segerstrom High School

Apply for Passport

Apply in person for a U.S. Passport at the Costa Mesa Post Office or another location that will accept passport applications as soon as possible.

Bring student's Certified U.S. Birth Certificate, completed forms, parent(s) and passport photos. Do not sign forms until asked to do so.

One parent must attend for youth age 16 & 17. Both parents must attend for youth younger than 16, or provide notarized consent form from the non-attending parent.

*** Youth who are not citizens of the United States should contact the [Peruvian embassy in Los Angeles](#) and/or the Consulate of their country of citizenship for questions about passport or visa requirements.*

Passport Timing: Apply as soon as possible. Color passport copies must be turned in on Tuesday, March 3, 2020. It takes four to six weeks to process a passport. Expedited passports can be processed in two to three weeks for an additional \$60.

Passport Fees: \$135 for 16 and 17-year-old youth
